



Photographic Competition

RULES

1. Entrants must be members of the Society, their family, or friends.
2. The full name and address of the entrant, and of their sponsor if they are not a member of the Society, must be firmly fixed to the reverse of the mounted work. Note: judges are not made aware of entrants' names.
3. Each competitor may submit up to two separate entries, each of a different subject. Each entry must be mounted on black A4 card or stiff paper. Any titles or legends must be fixed only to the back of the mounting.
4. Entries may be the result of traditional roll film or digital exposures. Enhancements must be no more than standard dark room practices might achieve.
5. Entrants must keep originals or copies of their submissions. Photographs submitted remain the property of the entrants, but by signing the entry form it is understood that the entrant gives permission for their photographs to be displayed and published in *The Heraldry Gazette*, or otherwise, if it is deemed appropriate to do so.
6. An email address – or a stamped, self-addressed envelope – should be enclosed for acknowledgement of safe receipt. A further stamped, self-addressed envelope should be enclosed for the return of submissions, if that is required.

GUIDANCE

Each entry must be the entrant's own original work. It should have strong heraldic content (either conventional or extraordinary) which is shown in context and not over-cropped.

The winner of the competition will be notified by post.
Results will be published in *The Heraldry Gazette* and the award presented at the Anniversary Luncheon in February.
